ALGERIAN COAST

Day 01 – Algiers

Discover the ancient city of Hippo and its Roman ruins, visit the iconic Basilica of Saint Augustine, enjoy a stroll through the city center, and admire breathtaking views from Seraïdi and the Corniche Chapuis.

Day 02 – Constantine

Explore the city of bridges overlooking the Rhummel Gorge, visit the Bey's Palace, wander through the historic Casbah and immerse yourself in the vibrant atmosphere of the local markets.

Day 03 – Constantine

Walk along the famous Tourist Trail through the spectacular gorges, discover the Roman ruins of Tiddis, and end the day at the majestic Emir Abdelkader Mosque.

Day 04 – Djemila & Béjaïa

Visit the UNESCO-listed Roman site of Djemila, renowned for its temples, mosaics and ancient ruins, before continuing to the coastal city of Béjaïa.

Day 05 – Béjaïa & Algiers

Admire panoramic views from Yemma Gouraya, discover the impressive cliffs and lighthouse of Cap Carbon, then continue to Algeria's capital, Algiers.

Day 06 – Algiers

Explore the capital's highlights including Notre-Dame d'Afrique, the historic Casbah, El Hamma Botanical Garden, and the iconic Martyrs' Memorial.

Day 07 – Tipaza & Cherchell – Ghardaïa

Visit the Royal Mausoleum of Mauretania, explore the Roman ruins of Tipaza and the Cherchell Museum, then fly to the desert city of Ghardaïa.

Day 08 – Ghardaïa

Discover the unique architecture and traditions of the M'Zab Valley through the old town, the underground mosque, the Beni Izguen market and the Boulila tower at sunset.

Day 09 – Ghardaïa – Oran

Visit traditional local markets before flying to Oran, where you will enjoy free time to discover the city at your own pace.

Day 10 – Oran

Explore Oran's main landmarks including Place d'Armes, the Sacred Heart Cathedral, Santa Cruz Fortress, the seafront promenade, and historic colonial sites.

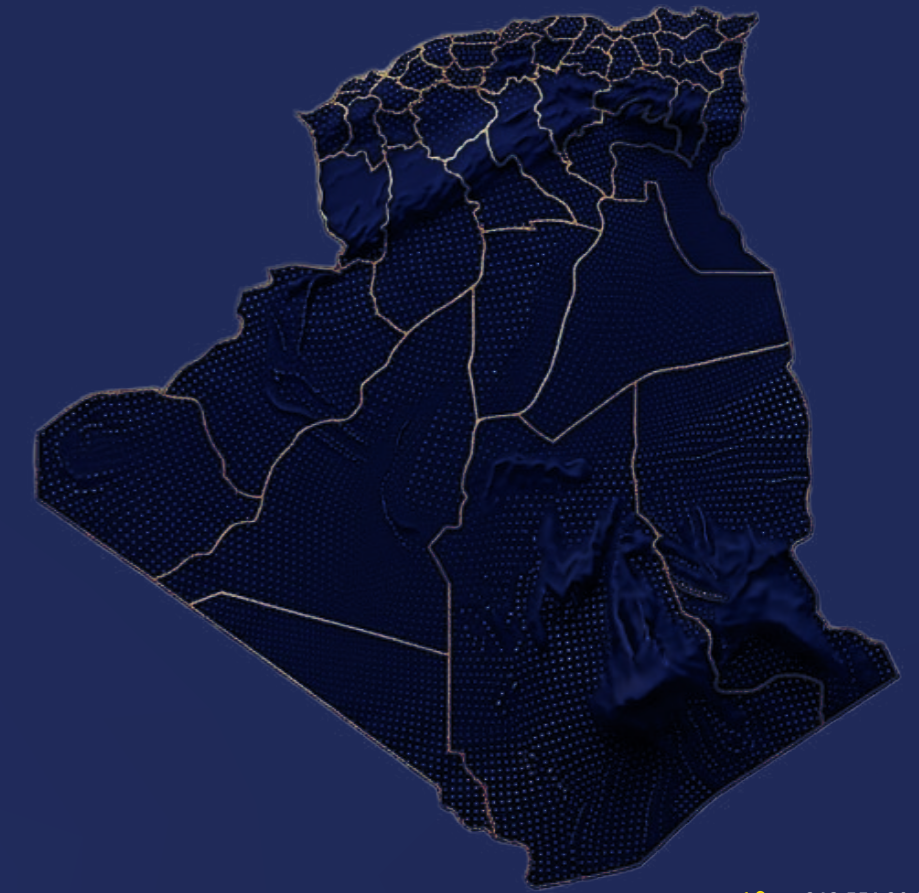
Day 11 – Tlemcen

Discover the cultural and spiritual heritage of Tlemcen through the Great Mosque, El Mechouar Palace, Sidi Boumediene Mausoleum, Beni Add Caves and El Mansorah.

Day 12 – Departure

Transfer according to departure times, taking home unforgettable memories of Algeria's history, culture, landscapes and hospitality.

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AT THE HEART OF THE ROMAN EMPIRE

Day 01 – Algiers

Discover the historic Casbah of Algiers, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, explore the Dar El Soltan Citadel and the Mustapha Bacha Palace, visit the iconic Ketchaoua Mosque, and enjoy panoramic views over the bay from Notre-Dame d’Afrique.

Day 02 – Tipaza & Cherchell

Explore the UNESCO-listed Roman ruins of Tipaza overlooking the Mediterranean, visit the Royal Mausoleum of Mauretania, then continue to Cherchell to discover its archaeological museum and ancient Roman remains.

Day 03 – Biskra

Fly to Biskra, the gateway to the Sahara, discover the famous thermal springs of Hammam Salhine, and visit the spectacular site of El Kantara.

Day 04 – Biskra & Rhoufi Gorges

Discover the breathtaking Rhoufi Gorges and continue to the oasis village of M’Chouneche, surrounded by palm groves and stunning desert landscapes.

Day 05 – Timgad & Constantine

Visit Timgad, the “Pompeii of Africa” and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, famous for its remarkably preserved Roman ruins, ancient theatre, forum and triumphal arch, before continuing to Constantine.

Day 06 – Djemila & Constantine

Explore the UNESCO-listed Roman site of Djemila, renowned for its temples, basilicas, mosaics and ancient ruins, then return to Constantine.

Day 07 – Constantine

Spend the day discovering Constantine, the city of suspended bridges, including the Rhummel Gorges, Bey’s Palace, Emir Abdelkader Mosque, the Cirta Museum and the historic Casbah.

Day 08 – Guelma & Annaba

Visit the city of Guelma, known for its thermal springs and Roman heritage, before continuing to Annaba, the pearl of eastern Algeria.

Day 09 – Annaba

Discover the ancient city of Hippo and its Roman ruins, visit the Basilica of Saint Augustine, stroll through the city center, and enjoy breathtaking views from Seraïdi and the Corniche Chapuis.

Day 10 – Departure

Return to Algiers with free time depending on flight schedules, ending the journey with unforgettable memories of Algeria’s history, culture and landscapes.

THE OASIS ROUTE

Day 01 – Oran

Discover the highlights of Oran including Place d’Armes, the Sacred Heart Cathedral, Santa Cruz Fortress via Sidi El Houari, the birthplace of Yves Saint Laurent, the Arenas, and the lively seafront promenade

Day 02 – Oran & Tlemcen

Travel to Tlemcen and explore the Beni Add Caves, the Mausoleum of Sidi Boumediene, the Great Mosque, and the historic El Mechouar and El Mansourah Palaces.

Day 03 – Aïn Sefra

Journey to Aïn Sefra, the gateway to the Sahara, and enjoy the peaceful Tiout Oasis with its palm groves and authentic desert atmosphere.

Day 04 – Moghrrar & Taghit

Visit the historic Ksar of Moghrrar before continuing through breathtaking Saharan landscapes towards the desert oasis of Taghit.

Day 05 – Taghit

Explore the Old Ksar of Taghit, climb Jbel Baroun, discover the lake and prehistoric rock engravings, and admire a magical sunset over the dunes.

Day 06 – Béni Abbès

Discover the oasis town of Béni Abbès, visit the Ksar Moulay Abdessalam, enjoy a 4x4 excursion or relaxation in the dunes, and experience an evening of traditional local music

Day 07 – Timimoun

Travel across spectacular desert landscapes towards Timimoun with a stop in Kerzaz, ending the day with a memorable sunset over the dunes.

Day 08 – Timimoun

Explore Timimoun’s palm groves and traditional foggara irrigation system, enjoy a camel trek in the Sahara, and discover the ancient Ksar Draâ.

Day 09 – El Goléa

Continue to El Goléa with a stop in M’Ghiden, visit the National Museum and Saint Joseph Church, home to the tomb of Charles de Foucauld, and discover the nearby salt lake.

Day 10 – Ghardaïa

Travel to Ghardaïa and discover its traditional market, lush palm groves, and the UNESCO-listed irrigation system of the M’Zab Valley.

Day 11 – Ghardaïa

Explore the old town of Ghardaïa, visit the underground Sheikh Ammi Said Mosque, wander through the famous Beni Izguen market, and admire sunset views from the Boulila Tower.

Day 12 – Algiers

Fly to Algiers and discover the historic Casbah, the Palace of the Rais, the Ketchaoua Mosque, the peaceful Hamma Botanical Garden, and the iconic Martyrs’ Memorial.

Day 13 – Tipaza & Cherchell

Visit the UNESCO-listed Roman ruins of Tipaza and the Royal Mausoleum of Mauretania, then continue to Cherchell to explore its archaeological museum and ancient remains.

Day 14 – Departure

Enjoy free time in Algiers before your transfer to the airport, ending an unforgettable journey through Algeria’s cities, desert landscapes and cultural heritage

DJANET : IHRIR

Day 01 – Essendilène

Fly from Algiers to Djanet before crossing the spectacular Erg Edmer by 4x4 to reach Essendilène. Enjoy a hike through the canyon to the guelta, with time for swimming and relaxation in the heart of the Tassili landscapes.

Day 02 – Tikoubaouine

Discover the extraordinary site of Tikoubaouine, famous for its monumental natural arch and prehistoric rock paintings, followed by a hike to the guelta and an authentic bivouac experience under the desert sky.

Day 03 – Adaik, Tilalen & Imourouden

Journey through the breathtaking desert landscapes of Adaik and Tilalen, explore the Imourouden cave, and enjoy a magical evening beneath the stars in the Sahara.

Day 04 – Kalambo, Tigharghart & Djanet

Visit remarkable desert sites including the keyhole tomb, the Elephant Rock and the famous “Weeping Cow” rock carvings, before returning to Djanet to explore the local market and shop for souvenirs.

Day 05 – Algiers

Discover the historic Casbah of Algiers, visit the Dar El Soltan Citadel and the Mustapha Bacha Palace, explore the iconic Ketchaoua Mosque, and admire panoramic views from Notre-Dame d’Afrique.

Day 06 – Tipaza & Cherchell
